- **Time and Distance** – About 1.5 hours, with a distance of 3 mile.
- **Degree of Difficulty** – Easy. Mostly smooth terrain.

BLT is offering a unique community walk which will feature the past, present and the future of Lebanon. The group will meet at Had Irvine Park then cross the highway to the new Reeves Parkway trail to view beautiful pasture land and Lowe's distribution center. The walk will continue past Pioneer School and on to Academy Square where the new library, police station, and labyrinth walk projects will be constructed. We will then continue to Pioneer Cemetery, a site rich with history, and end up at Had Irvine Park.

The walk will be on pavement and gravel. Bring a sack lunch or snack to enjoy afterwards!

To reach Had Irvine Park in Lebanon, Turn off of Main Street (at Ixtapa Restaurant) and travel east on Wheeler Street. Had Irvine Park is located just over the Albany-Santiam Canal bridge across from the Bridgeport Condominiums. Look for the BLT event signs to lead you to the parking area.
