**We will be meeting rain or shine on the north side of the Butte.
To reach this location:**

Travel west on Airport Road out of Lebanon about 1 mile past the airport. At the first bend in the road do not turn, but go straight onto Polly Farm Lane. BLT event signs will guide you to the parking location.

Remember to bring your binoculars!
