- This loop hike will provide five variable distances from a ½ mile on up to 5 miles. The hike will start at Pioneer School, head north to Reeves Parkway, west to Hansard, South to Harrison, jog over to Fifth and back north to Pioneer School.
- This hike will be the site of the annual Act Alive Decathlon event on July 13 that BLT is endorsing and will be participating in. Act Alive is an exciting way to challenge yourself and raise money for and awareness of diabetes at the same time! Learn more about Act Alive at the June 9 hike.
